This circuit breaker features a contact position indicator and a local signaling system that allows for easy identification of the device's status.

Its compact design, with dimensions of 85 mm in height, 36 mm in width, and 78.5 mm in depth, facilitates its installation on DIN rails, making it compatible with distribution blocks and busbars.
