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Description

The Gu10 Country 2 Focus Roof App of the M LEDME brand is a lighting device designed to be mounted on roofs, incorporating two GU10 light sources. Its aluminium construction and standard 220-240V ac power supply make it a functional option for indoor spaces where easy and reliable installation is required.

Due to its material and dimensions, this applique offers a lightweight but resistant structure, suitable for integration into suspended or recessed lighting systems on flat ceilings. The IP20 protection indicates that it is designed exclusively for use in dry environments and protected against accidental splashing, so its application is limited to indoors where there is no risk of direct humidity.

The installation requires connecting the power supply according to local regulations and securing the support on the ceiling before attaching the body of the applicator. The operation is standard for low

voltage or alternating current lamps, without the need for external transformers if the GU10 sources are direct.
